2. Reports/Updates:

- a. Principal - Ms. Lauren Tobias
 1. Enrollment 558.
 2. SAT for 11th graders successful on March 4
 - a. Scores to be released in April.
 - b. SAT was free for any junior or senior (who has not taken it).
 3. Students are encouraged to take 1 AP class.
 4. Finalizing master schedule for the 26-27 school year. Counselors meeting soon with students to go over classes.
 5. Parent question: Can sports receive uniform pieces from donation
 - a. As long as they are not worn during athletic competitions they can be donated.
 - b. Parent asked about whether items like water jugs could be used from other sports. Answer: Yes.
 - c. There is a cap on how much money can be donated to a club/sport.
 - d. Parent asked about bringing back booster club (been non-existent since 2019). Ms. Tobias advised PTSO fills the roll of the booster.
 - e. Question was brought to the table regarding fundraising in off-season.
 - i. Fundraising off season is allowed

1. Mental health services for students.
 - a. Garrison is still working on a directory of resources regarding where civilians could get immediate help. Will give guidelines about on post/off post help. Will post information on the "My Army" app once created. Family life chaplain is available 24/7. No information provided on HOW to get ahold of them. Gaps in

coverage for “off-duty” hours.

3. Parent submission: Information on No Cellphone Policy per the 2026 National Defense Authorization Act mandates that Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) schools prohibit student smartphone use during instructional hours. Phones must be stored in secure containers, lockers, or pouches during the day, with exceptions for emergencies and medical needs
 - a. How and when will this be implemented/enforced, what are the consequences of violations etc.
 - b. Concerns: there are frequent internet interruptions and or outages that affect instructional time and lessons without internet service. Teachers and staff have encouraged and recommended that student's hotspot their own cell phones to their DODEA computers to access the internet.
 - c. Continuance of conversation asked about numbers changing for the front office of the school.
 - i. WHS has no response at this time as no guidance has been put forth from DoWEA
